Benaki Museum and Kolonaki Shopping tour

You will visit the Benaki Museum (the oldest museum in Greece). The museum contains more than 30,000 items illustrating the character of the Greek World through a spectacular historical panorama from prehistoric times and the age of Roman domination to the medieval Byzantine period through centuries of Frankish and Ottoman occupation through modern-day Greece.

Kolonaki is the most elegant and beautiful shopping area of Athens stretching out to the foot of Lycabetus Hill with big squares, nice expensive shops, lots of coffee shops, taverns and restaurants.

You will visit the National Archeological Museum, one of the most important museums of the country, where you can follow the Greek history through a very rich collection of exhibits.
